She served as Clinical Chaplain at the State Psychiatric Hospital in New Hampshire working with patients, staff, clergy, and churches to increase understanding and welcome of persons living with mental illness. She has served on the New Suicide Prevention Council. Since her ordination in 1992, Rachael has served in diverse ministry settings, traditional and non-traditional. She has a Master of Divinity degree from Princeton Theological Seminary, a Masters from Princeton in Christian Education and Counseling, and a doctoral degree (DMin) from Andover Newton Theological School. She is also a painter and a poet.
